



## National Panhellenic Conference

### NATIONAL PANHELLENIC CONFERENCE STRATEGIC PLAN 2005-2010

Whereas, The Board of Directors met in October, 2004, and with input from the Inter/national Presidents of the 26 member organizations, decided to launch a strategic planning process over the next calendar year;

Whereas, the Executive Committee assigned the responsibility for the development of this strategic planning process and the pursuit of a professional consultant to guide the process to the Long Range Planning Committee;

Whereas, The Waters Pelton Organization, Inc. with Charlotte Pelton, President of the firm as lead Strategic Counsel, was selected to establish and coordinate a planning process and to develop a Strategic Plan for the National Panhellenic Conference;

Whereas, an inclusive strategic planning process was conducted over a ten-month period and included widespread data collection involving many audiences;

Whereas, the Long Range Planning Committee and Strategic Counsel worked together to create a Strategic Plan document that incorporates findings from the data collection and the input from all members;

Whereas, all members received various drafts of the Strategic Plan and were asked to study the content and provide feedback;

Whereas, an organization's strategic plan is a guide to the future and requires constant attention, progress reports, evaluation and adjustment as new information develops and circumstances change or arise; and

Whereas, The Strategic Plan document incorporates all of the requirements delineated in the resolution that was adopted by the Board of Directors approving the selection of The Waters Pelton Organization;

**Resolved,** That the document entitled *National Panhellenic Conference Strategic Plan: 2005-2010* be adopted as the Strategic Plan for the National Panhellenic Conference and that changes and adjustments can be made as necessary;

**Resolved,** That the Long Range Planning Committee be assigned the responsibility for guiding the implementation of the Strategic Plan under the direction and approval of the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors and provide quarterly reports to the Board of Directors; and

**Resolved,** That the Strategic Plan be reviewed annually and revised as necessary by the Board of Directors.
